

How to dispose of garbage

Please dispose of garbage in the green or blue garbage bag designated by Gotemba City.



- Put out garbage by **8:30 am on the collection day** at the garbage collection site.

Cannot put out garbage on the day before and night.

- **You cannot put out garbage unless you write your name or household number on the garbage bag designated by Gotemba City.**

- Please follow the rules for using the garbage collection area.

- Please call us for oversized garbage.

Burnable garbage ...Do not mix incombustible waste or resources such as bottles and cans.



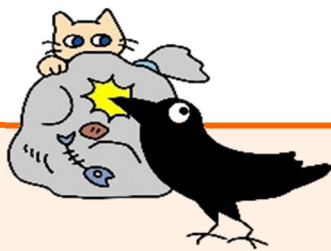
Collected:

Twice a week

- Tie the designated green garbage bag designated by Gotemba City.
- Drain the water well before disposing of the raw garbage.
- Garbage that does not fit in a 45-liter garbage bag is oversized garbage.
- See page 2 for disposable diapers only.

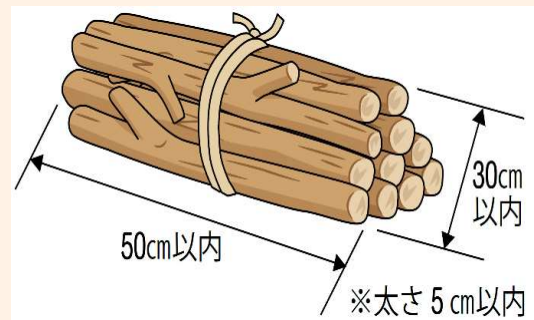
※Cover by the net.

※You can't put out garbage without writing your full name or household number.



<How to throw away tree branches>

- Tree branches can be thrown away as shown in the picture below.



※Please call when there is a lot of garbage.



Be sure to put out burnable garbage in the green garbage bag designated by Gotemba City. You can't put out the garbage without writing your full name or address (household number).



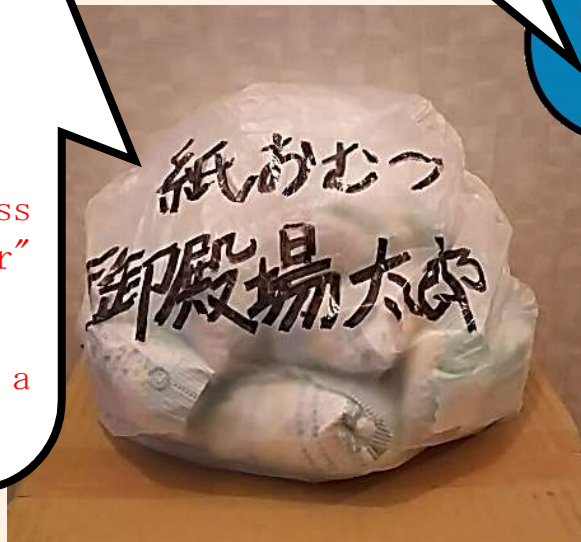
○ How to put out paper diapers

Only disposable diapers can be put out in the visible bag inside.
(You can also use the green garbage bag designated by Gotemba City.)

【How to put out】

- Tie the garbage bag.
- Paper diapers only.
- You can't put out unless you write "Paper diaper" and your own "Name".
- Use garbage bag with a visible inside.

Put out on the day of burnable garbage.



This is no good.

Collected:


Twice a month

- Tie the top of blue garbage bag designated by Gotemba city.
- If the garbage have a sharp point or part, wrap its part by paper and use the blue garbage bag designated by Gotemba city.
- Please call us when you want to put out the soil of planter.

<How to put out umbrellas>

- Items that do not fit a 45-liter garbage bags are oversized garbage.
- Even if the umbrella sticks out of the bag, it is possible to dispose of it in the blue garbage bag designated by Gotemba city.



✖ Please call us when there is a lot of garbage. 

Dispose of non-burnable garbage in the blue garbage bag designated by Gotemba City.

You can't put out the garbage without writing your name or address(household number).



Cans • • • Cans with remaining contents cannot be thrown away.



Collected: Twice a month

- You can also put out cans of powdered milk and cans of sweets.
- Rusted cans and spray cans cannot be thrown away.
(Rusted cans and spray cans can be put out as incombustible garbage)
- Cans remaining contents cannot be put out.



Bottle • • • Bottles with remaining contents cannot be thrown away.



Collected: Twice a month

- Food bottles can be thrown away.
- Glass or ceramics cups cannot be thrown away. Cups can be thrown away as incombustible garbage.
- Bottles with non-removable lids or caps can not be removed can be put out.



Metals • • • Those that are 80% or more metal can be thrown way.



Collected: Twice a month

- Put out batteries in a bag where you can see the contents.
- Large items that do not fit in a 45-liter garbage are "oversized garbage".
- Metal rods can be thrown away up to 1.5m in size.
- Hammers and nail crowbars can be thrown away.
- Rusted things cannot be thrown away.



Small-sized electrical appliances • • • can put out appliances that run on electricity and batteries



Collected: Twice a month

- Small-sized electrical appliances can not be thrown away unless the battery is removed.
- Large items that do not fit in a 45-liter garbage are “oversized garbage” .



Spray cans, etc • • • You can throw it away without making a hole.



Collected: Twice a month

- Even if the contents are contained, They can not be collected.
- Spray can with the lid that cannot be removed can be put out.



PET bottles • • • can put out in a blue net.



Collected: Twice a month

- If you do not rinse the inside and not remove the lid and label, you can not put out.
- The removed lid or label can be put out as a burnable garbage.
- Dirty PET bottles can be put out as burnable garbage.

Recycled paper • • • Please divide into types and throw away



Collected: Twice a month

- Can not put out paper garbage in the rainy day and snow day.
- Please divide into types, bundle them with a paper string and put them out .
- Miscellaneous paper can be thrown away in a paper bag.

Lighter, Batteries, Cylinders • • • You can throw them away in a clear plastic bag where you can see the contents



👉 Lighter

Collected: Twice a month

- Put out lighters in a clear plastic bag where you can see the contents.



👉 Batteries

- Put out batteries in a clear bag where you can see the contents.
- Put out carbon dioxide (CO₂) or gas cartridge type cylinder in a clear plastic bag where you can see the contents.
